1.	A	Enter in medium walk. Proceed down the centre line at C Track right	10
2.	M	Transition to working trot.	10
3	B	Circle right 10m diameter	10
4	A	Circle left 10 meters diameter, (20m if driven) returning to A	10
5	F	Transition to Medium Walk	10
6	A	Halt and rein back four strides, proceed in medium walk	10
7	K	Transition to working trot.	10
8	E	Circle right 10 meters diameter, (20m if driven) returning to A	10
9	H	Transition to medium walk	10
10	C	Halt, immobility four seconds and proceed in working trot	10
11	M X K	Change the rein show lengthened stride over 'X'	10
12	A	3 loop serpentine to each side of the track at C on the right rein.	10
13	C	Medium walk.	10
14	M E	Change rein in free walk on a long rein	10
15	E F	Change rein in free walk on a long rein	10
16	F	Medium walk	10
