Health Requirements: Owners are responsible for knowing and meeting any health requirements regarding the exhibition of the horses and their transport between their home location and the show. Please check with your local veterinarian if you are unsure of the current requirements.

Exhibitors: A membership with MHCGB is required.

- MHCGB Reserves the right to refuse entry without reason.
- Exhibitors must be suitably turned out, 12 years and under must wear a British approved hard hat.
- Children 12 years and under are not permitted to exhibit at Stallion.
- It is the owner/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes, late arrivals will not be allowed into the ring once the class has stared unless the ring steward is made aware of the lateness beforehand.
- Exhibitors are reminded not to contact any of the judges prior to the show to discuss horses they will be exhibiting.
- Exhibitors are reminded judges will not penalize any horse with whiskers remaining.
- Refunds will not be given unless a veterinary certificate is provided to say the horse is unable to show due to illness or injury.

Conduct:

- Cruelty, abuse, or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, or stalls, or on the showground is strictly prohibited.
- MHCGB code of conduct of its members should be always adhered to.
- Conduct by any exhibitor, producer/trainer or owner deemed unsportsmanlike, abusive or detrimental will not be tolerated, any person found guilty of such conduct should be reported immediately to the show manager.

House Keeping:

- We kindly ask you to respect the venue and the staff.
- Dispose of any rubbish carefully, and do not muck out lorries in the car parks or onto the field, please use the muck heap provided.
- Strictly no hay, feed, grass in the arena, or use of hoof blacking or chalk in the indoor arena or in stable barns. Please bring carpet to stand your horse on.

Stables:

- Stabling is available, Indoor barn stables and facilities are reserved ONLY for sponsors. Anyone who is not a sponsor is not permitted to use the indoor washing facilities.

Dogs: Dogs are allowed outside the venue; however they are to be kept on a lead at ALL times and are not permitted in the café or the decking area in the arena.

Measuring: MHCGB will not be measuring, however MHCGB reserves the right to conduct spot check measurements and /or measure if a complaint is made. Please ensure you know your horse's height and you enter the correct height classes.

Rules for Breed/Type Sections

AMHCGB Classes: Open to horses holding an AMHCGB passport or an EU passport that has been over stamped into the AMHCGB breeding book.

Amateur Rules: Please refer to MHCGB rule book page 14.

Rescue Class: The RESS (Rescue equine showing society) rules - Definition of Rescue: 1. Any equine that is adopted, fostered, under a guardianship scheme from any National Equine Welfare Council registered Charity (NEWC). 2. Any equine that has been adopted, fostered, under a guardianship scheme from any other equine charity (must be registered with the Charity Commission).

3. Any equine that has been 'independently' rescued by an individual. There must be supporting evidence (photographic, veterinary) that will be included in the 'Rescue History' for the equine, to demonstrate their rescue status. Mark System: The mark system is designed to reward those equines that have the strongest rescue history and most dramatic 'transformation'. Marks are awarded as follows: Rescue History and Transformation - 60% Performance - 40% In the event of a tie, the Rescue History and Transformation takes precedence. All entries are asked to provide, on entry to the class, a written 'Rescue History', detailing the background and history of the equine. Also, to be included are 'before' and 'after' photographs. This will be for the Judge to discuss with the competitor during the Judging of the Class and marks awarded accordingly. (A template for the layout for this Rescue History can be found on the Rescue Equine Showing Society website).

AOTE Rules: Open to horses shown and trained by their owner who has amateur status

AMHA/AMHR/ASPC section classes: Open to horses that are registered with the appropriate US Registry.

Part- bred classes: These are open to horses with either parent registered with the appropriate US Registry. .

Refined Type Classes: These are open to horses not exceeding 34" at maturity for Category A & are open to horses exceeding 34" but not exceeding 38" at maturity for Category B (measured at the last hairs of the mane).

Middleweight Type Classes: These are open to horses not exceeding 34" at maturity for Category A & are open to horses exceeding 34" but not exceeding 38" at maturity for Category B (measured at the last hairs of the mane).

Draft Type Class: These are open to horses not exceeding 34" at maturity for Category A & are open to horses exceeding 34" but not exceeding 38" at maturity for Category B (measured at the last hairs of the mane).

English Heritage Classes: These are open to horses with neither parent registered with <u>American</u> or a <u>Falabella bloodlines</u> or of <u>unknown breeding</u> not exceeding 38" at maturity (measured at the last hairs of the mane).

Category B Classes: These are open to horses expected to mature at a height exceeding 34" but not exceeding 38".

Show Horse In Miniature Classes: These are open to horses not exceeding 38" and is judged on the horse most resembling that specified type in miniature.

MHCGB Restricted Classes: These Classes are open to handlers or horses that have never been placed Supreme, Reserve or Res Res at our Spring Nationals or Grand Champs Show or at MHOYS, RI, HOYS or Any Other Miniature Only Show. Open to horses any age not exceeding 38"

Performance Classes: These are open to horses not exceeding 38" at maturity (measured at the last hairs of the mane).

Show Rules on age: Driving horses 3 years plus, Jumping horses 3 years plus, Liberty 2 years plus. Halter obstacle 2 years plus.

Completed Colour Challenge 'have a go judge' cards will be handed to the ring steward and the 'have a go judge' will leave the ring. For those watching on Facebook they must photograph their cards and send to the designated MHCGB messenger account prior to the announcement of the top placed horses. The actual Judge will then enter the ring and judge the class placing their top six horses and the first placed horse in each colour category. All proceeds from the £5 judge's cards will be shared between the top six placed horses overall and the winning 'have a go judge' who has the highest marks closest to the actual class judge. The winning 'have a go judge' will also receive The Colour Challenge Cup. This should prove to be a real fun class, with the opportunity to also compete if you are not a miniature horse owner and at the show. Plus the chance to win not only cash prizes but the beautiful Colour Challenge Cup trophy to take home!
